Understanding Encounter vs Meeting



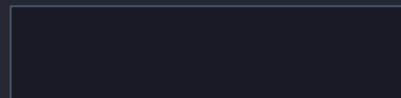
Meeting

A scheduled event with a set agenda, fixed time, and location.



Encounter

An unplanned event happening without a fixed time or place.

Personal Encounter

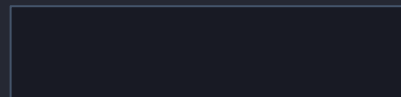
Unexpected, meaningful moments with God or nature

Life-changing Encounter

Meeting that transforms beliefs and perspectives

Spiritual Encounter

Direct experience of God's presence or power

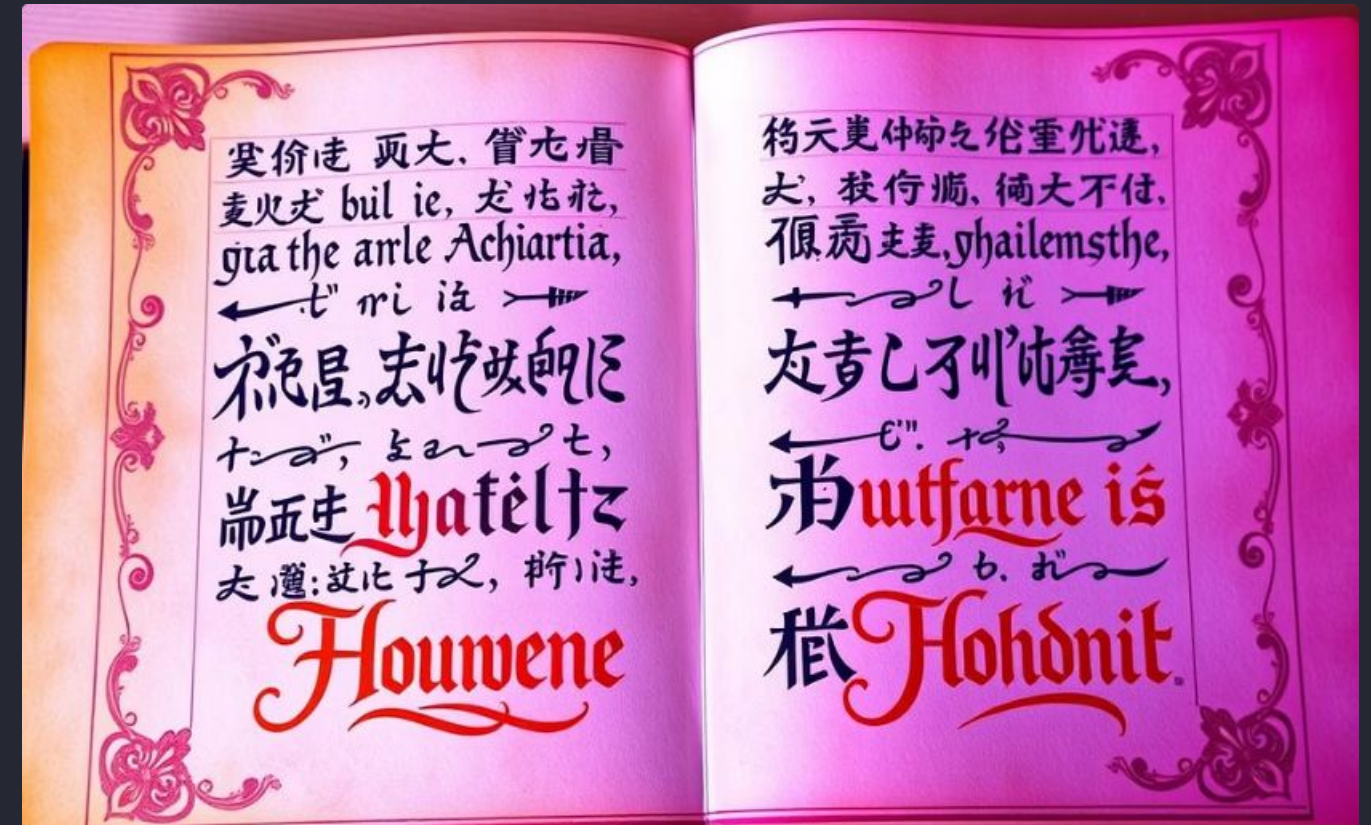


Meaning of Reveal and Names



Reveal

- Unveil hidden truths
- Disclose what was once concealed
- Bring to light what was previously unseen



Names

- Define identity and significance
- Carry meaning, authority, and power
- Convey relationships and roles

Reveal Name: God's Identity (types)



Primary Names

YHWH, Elohim, Adonai, El represent
God's foundational identities



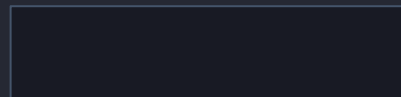
Compound Names

Names expressing God's nature and
specific attributes

Meaning of the Name

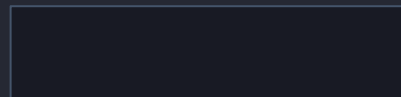
"To be" or "to exist"

Embrace our need for God's sufficiency and help



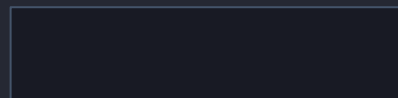
Accept Jesus as Lord
