Overview

By the grace of God, the Home and Urban Missions (HUM) team successfully embarked on a Truck Drivers Outreach to intentionally reach members of the trucking community with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The outreach created an opportunity to meet drivers where they work, engage them personally, share the message of salvation, and demonstrate the love of Christ through practical acts of kindness.

Outreach Activities

- Shared the Gospel of Jesus Christ through personal conversations and one-on-one engagement.
- Distributed food and refreshments to truck drivers and others encountered during the outreach.
- Distributed church invitation cards and encouraged recipients to fellowship with the church whenever they are in the area.
- Invited drivers whose work schedules keep them on the road to connect with church services and fellowship online.
- Built relationships and opened opportunities for continued spiritual engagement with the trucking community.
